UPDATED UNIFORM POLICY 2026 - 2027

Students attending Holy Savior Academy are required to wear a prescribed school uniform. The only companies from which school uniform apparel may be purchased:

- School Uniform by Tommy Hilfiger (Visit www.globalschoolwear.com - school code HOLY63)
- Flynn O'Hara Uniforms (<https://flynnohara.com/shop/holy-savior-academy-nj236>).

All uniforms should be clearly marked with the child's name.

Pre-Kindergarten: Boys and Girls

- Comfortable and appropriate play clothes
- Sneakers

Summer Uniform: Start of School until October 31 and April 1 through June

Girls: Kindergarten through Grade 4

- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Navy uniform skort
- Navy or white knee or crew socks (NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS)
- Sneakers (all white, all black, or black/white combo ONLY); no flashing lights
- Red uniform sweater

Girls: Grade 5 through Grade 8

- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Navy skorts or uniform wrap around kilt (knee length)
- Navy or white knee or crew socks (NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS)
- Sneakers should be worn with skort (all white, all black, or black/white combo ONLY) • Uniform shoe should be worn with kilt
- Red uniform sweater

Boys: Kindergarten through Grade 8

- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Navy walking shorts
- Navy crew socks (NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS)
- Sneakers (all white, all black, or black/white combo ONLY); no flashing lights
- Red uniform sweater

Winter Uniform: November 1 through March 31

Girls: Kindergarten through Grade 4

- White button down blouse with Peter Pan Collar (with jumper)
- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Plaid jumper (knee length), skort, or navy pants *See note below
- Navy or white knee socks (NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS) or navy tights
- Uniform shoe (see below)
- Red uniform sweater, vest, or ¼ zip sweater with insignia

* Girls jumpers, kilts or skorts should be to the bottom of the knee or below. NO kilt or skort should be rolled up.

Girls: Grade 5 through Grade 8

- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Uniform wrap around kilt (knee length) or skort or navy pants *See note below
- Navy or white knee socks (NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS) or navy tights
- Uniform shoe (see below)
- Red uniform sweater, vest, or ¼ zip sweater with insignia

* Girls jumpers, kilts or skorts should be to the bottom of the knee or below. NO kilt or skort should be rolled up.

Boys: Kindergarten through Grade 8

- Navy or white polo shirt only with HSA insignia (tucked in)
- Navy pants
- Belt
- Navy socks
- Uniform shoe (see below)
- Red uniform sweater, vest, or ¼ zip sweater with insignia

Uniform Shoes:

Girls: (Grades K through 8)

- Shoes should be black, blue, or brown with rubber soles. Solid colors only. Mary Janes, tie shoes, slip ons with backs only.

Boys: (Grades K through 8)

- Shoes should be black, blue, or brown with rubber soles. Solid colors only.

No heels, open back shoes, clogs, Crocs, Ugg slippers or Ugg boots, moccasins, or boots of any kind. This includes work boots, hiking boots, Uggs, ankle boots, cowboy boots, and combat boots. During inclement weather, the children may wear boots to school. However, they must change into their uniform shoes upon arrival in school.

Additional Uniform Requirements

- No make up allowed. This includes lip gloss. Only Chapstick may be used.
- Clear nail polish only. No acrylic gels or tips.
- **Girls:** Hairstyles, as well as hair adornments for girls, should be simple.
- Hair coloring is not permitted. Hair dye, highlights, streaking not permitted.
- **Boys:** Hair should be no longer than collar length. NO mohawks, faux hawks, or designs cut into the hair.
- Watches permitted. However, NO SMART WATCHES ALLOWED.
- Necklaces with religious medals may be worn.
- No bangle or excessive amounts of bracelets allowed.
- Earrings: Girls: No hoop or dangling earrings. Post earrings only. Only one earring per ear.
- Earrings: Boys: The boys are not allowed to wear earrings to school.

Uniform violations will be as follows:

- First Offense - Verbal warning and note/email to parents
- Second Offense - Detention
- Third Offense - Parent/Student/Principal conference

Gym Uniform

Gym uniforms are to be worn to school on gym days by all students in grades Kindergarten through 8. (*These uniforms are to be ordered and purchased from Flynn and O'Hara.*)

- Gray or red uniform shirts; Spirit Wear or Drama shirts are allowed.
- Gray or red uniform shorts; Spirit Wear allowed.
- Gray uniform sweatshirt; Spirit Wear allowed.
- Gray uniform sweatpants; Spirit Wear allowed.
- White crew socks. NO LOW CUT OR NO SHOW SOCKS
- Sneakers (all white, all black, or black/white combo ONLY); no flashing lights

Any student not in proper gym uniform will not be permitted to take gym.

Students are expected to have jackets or coats as the weather gets cooler. Students without jackets or coats may not be allowed outside for recess.

Lost and Found is located in the Main Office. All items will be turned over to the Uniform Exchange at the end of every quarter.

Dress Down

Dress down days are sponsored by the school in order to support important Spirit Days, school projects, school clubs, functions, or charities. Regulations for dress down days are listed below. Rules specific to a particular dress down day (for example, school colors) will be communicated to the parents and students beforehand.

The guidelines below pertain to all dress down days.

The following items are not permitted:

- Any article inconsistent with our Catholic philosophy of education and values.
- No tops with inappropriate pictures or words.
- Any article which is excessively worn or soiled (No pants with holes or rips).
- Clothing which does not cover the body appropriately (Ex. tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, short tops, short shorts, low cut tops, pants worn below the waistline, shirts that do not come to the waistline).
- Any item that is excessively tight fitting or too short.
- High heels, open back shoes, flip flops, slides and slippers.
- Any item that may cause a safety risk to the student or his/her classmates.
- Hats, caps or headgear.
- Makeup, jewelry, or additional articles that would not be permitted on a regular uniform day. All students are expected to be neat, clean, and well groomed.

All sweaters, vests, sweatshirts, sweatpants, jackets, coats, lunchboxes, and water bottles should be clearly labeled with your child's name.

Uniform code will be strictly enforced. Parental cooperation is fully expected. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be required to call a parent/guardian and have them bring the school uniform to school for the child to change into.

The administration reserves the right to make the final decisions regarding the appropriateness and acceptability of student dress in school.
