The packet will be emailed to you and is also available online on our website, however, a hard copy of the contract and bus form is attached for your convenience. These two are the most important forms to be sent back with your \$100.00 re-registration fee due **March 1, 2018**. After March 1<sup>st</sup>, the fee will be \$250.00. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Holy Savior Academy will still offer our new student referral rebate. You can refer a **new** family in grades K through 7 and each family receives a 12.5% tuition rebate at the end of the school year. All forms are online on the website [holysavioracademy.com](http://holysavioracademy.com) under registration.

Tuition Assistance for both **Catholic and Non-Catholic** K-7 families for the 2018-19 school year will be available online beginning January 29, 2018 only through FACTS at <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Online applications are available in English and Spanish. Instructions are also on the site. The application fee is \$30.00 and **must** be paid online at the time you submit the application. All documentation must be submitted also at this time. Please remember the deadline for the application is **March 31, 2018**.
